Verified by B Lab, the not-for-profit behind the B Corp movement, the certification recognises that Dalcour Maclaren meets high standards of social and environmental performance, transparency and accountability alongside a commitment to goals beyond shareholder value.

The news comes as the ongoing climate crisis and widening social inequality continue to pose urgent challenges to our economy. B Corp Certification assesses the entirety of a business's operations and covers five main impact areas related to practices around governance, workers, community, the environment and customers.

Achieving B Corp certification required Dalcour Maclaren to undergo a rigorous assessment of its social and environmental performance, providing detailed evidence across areas including environmental impact, social values, employee wellbeing, diversity and inclusion, governance and transparency. The company has also legally embedded its commitment to balancing purpose and profit within its articles of association.

James Neil, CEO, Dalcour Maclaren, said: “This is a fantastic achievement for Dalcour Maclaren. B Corp status gives us the official badge that recognises everything that matters most to us in our culture, our values, and how we make decisions for our people and our clients. We thrive on doing things differently at DM and B Corp absolutely endorses this.”

Dalcour Maclaren is now part of a global community of more than 10,000 certified B Corps across over 100 countries and 160 industries. In the UK, the B Corp community is the largest and fastest-growing movement in the world, with more than 2,600 certified businesses including The Guardian, Innocent Drinks, Patagonia, Tony’s Chocolonely, The Big Issue, Finisterre, Elemis and Sipsmith Gin.

(The company is also a member of the Better Business Act coalition, which brings together more than 3,000 organisations calling for UK law to ensure all companies align the interests of shareholders with those of wider society and the environment.)
